Named after the German mathematician, astronomer, and astrologer who discovered the Supernova, Johannes Kepler, this luminaire is reminiscent of black holes and portals from science-fiction. The designers at Cohda have used highly innovative materials for this design, multiplying single LEDs over a large thin surface to widely refract the light and give the illusion of infinity.



The fine material, which has been likened to hosiery from the fashion industry, creates a fascinating effect, like a kaleidoscope of light rays. This woven translucent material is biodegradable and environmentally-friendly; a large impact from a small amount of innovative fabric.



With Kepler there is an opportunity to create huge and impressive light installations using very compact and lightweight units. Kepler is available in 2 sizes (65cm and 95cm diameter) to give a range of installation options.
